RESOLUTION NO. 33

"WHEREAS, the municipality of Mabinay acknowledges the vital role of the barangay officials as an instrument in the implementation and success of the government's enforcement agenda;

"WHEREAS, barangay officials are the frontliners in government service as the barangay serves as the primary planning and implementing unit of the government policies, projects, programs and activities of the national and municipal government;

"WHEREAS, barangay officials are given some benefits provided under the Local Government Code of 1991, such benefits are apparently minimal compared to the overwhelming tasks they have to perform under existing laws particularly in the area of peace and order and community relations despite the limited resources made available to them;

"WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan enacts such ordinance pursuant to Section 447-A of the Local Government Code of 1991 which provides that they may enact ordinances and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the same Code;

"WHEREAS, giving recognition and incentives on the basis of their length of service will boost their morale after their tenure;

"WHEREAS, barangay officials who had rendered service for three (3) consecutive terms are hereby given gratuity in recognition of service rendered to the municipality in addition to what is provided for under the law;

"NOW THEREFORE, on motion of: Honorable SB Member Ma. Rosario Ocay unanimously seconded by all other members present, the council

"RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to enact the following ordinance to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 7

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GUIDELINES
IN THE GRANT OF SERVICE BENEFITS/INCENTIVES
TO ALL ELECTED BARANGAY OFFICIALS IN MABINAY,
NEGROS ORIENTAL WHO HAVE RENDERED THREE
(3) CONSECUTIVE TERMS OF OFFICE.**

"Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Mabinay, Province of Negros Oriental in its Regular Session assembled that:

"SECTION 1 – All elected barangay officials who had completed three (3) consecutive terms as Punong Barangay or Barangay Kagawad are hereby given an "Exemplary Public Service Award (EPSA)."

Only the Punong Barangay or Barangay Kagawad who has not been declared guilty of any administrative or criminal offense by any government agency, quasi-judicial body or court of justice at any time during his/her term of office shall be entitled to the benefits provided under this ordinance.

"SECTION 2 – DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a.) Barangay Captain / Punong Barangay – is the chief executive exercising the basic duty of executing laws and ordinances applicable in the barangay and he exercises some legislative powers by being the presiding officer of the sangguniang barangay thus participating in the consideration and passage of barangay ordinances.
- b.) Barangay Kagawad – is the legislative body of the barangay that enacts ordinances as may be necessary to discharge the responsibilities conferred upon it by law or ordinance and to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants therein.

"SECTION 3 – The "Exemplary Public Service Award (EPSA)" shall consist of the following:

- a.) A Plaque of Appreciation
- b.) A cash reward of Six Thousand Pesos (P 6,000.00) for each three (3) termer Punong Barangay and Two Thousand Pesos (P 2,000.00) for each three (3) termer Barangay Kagawad.

The "Exemplary Public Service Award (EPSA)" shall be bestowed by the Municipal Mayor during the oath-taking of the new set of barangay officials.

"SECTION 4 – In cases where the highest ranking Barangay Kagawad shall succeed the position of Punong Barangay by virtue of operation of law under Title 2, Chapter 2 of the Local Government Code of 1991 on Vacancies and Successions on his third (3rd) term as Barangay Kagawad, the latter shall receive the same cash award as that given to Barangay Kagawad mentioned in this section.


"SECTION 5 – The municipality shall allocate funds for the distinguished exemplary public service award.

"SECTION 6 – The Barangay Council is hereby tasked to submit to the Office of the Municipal Mayor, the President of the Liga ng mga Barangay the list of qualified Barangay Officials entitled for the benefits.


"SECTION 7 – This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
